Project Background

The Logan Square Chamber of Commerce initiated this study to to understand whether additional neighborhood support services and business resources are desired along Milwaukee Avenue between Belmont and Armitage Avenue, and if so what types.

Special Service Areas (SSAs) are an economic development tool that helps maintain and promote a shared business district. Local businesses and organizations come together to decide how property tax dollars should be leveraged and applied to respond to the unique needs of the area. SSA services are in addition to those provided by the City and must be concentrated within the SSA boundaries.

Common SSA services include:

- Litter Abatement
- Corridor Maintenance
- Sidewalk Snow Plowing
- Business Marketing
- Facade Improvement Rebates
- Greening & Tree Installations
- Public Art & Programming

Process & Boundaries

The Logan Square Chamber has created a community outreach process that goes above and beyond what is required in state legislation. The process will feature several engagement events, a survey, community workshops, and advisory committee meetings.

- Phase 1: Start-up and Feasibility (January – February)
- Phase 2: Funding and Visioning (March)
- Phase 3: Needs Assessment and Metrics (March)
- Phase 4: SSA District Plan (March-April)
- Phase 5: Outreach (January – November)
- Phase 6: Application and Adoption (June-December)

The **proposed study area** extends along Milwaukee Avenue from Belmont south to Armitage Avenue; flip to see map on backside of this flyer.

Proposed Study Area

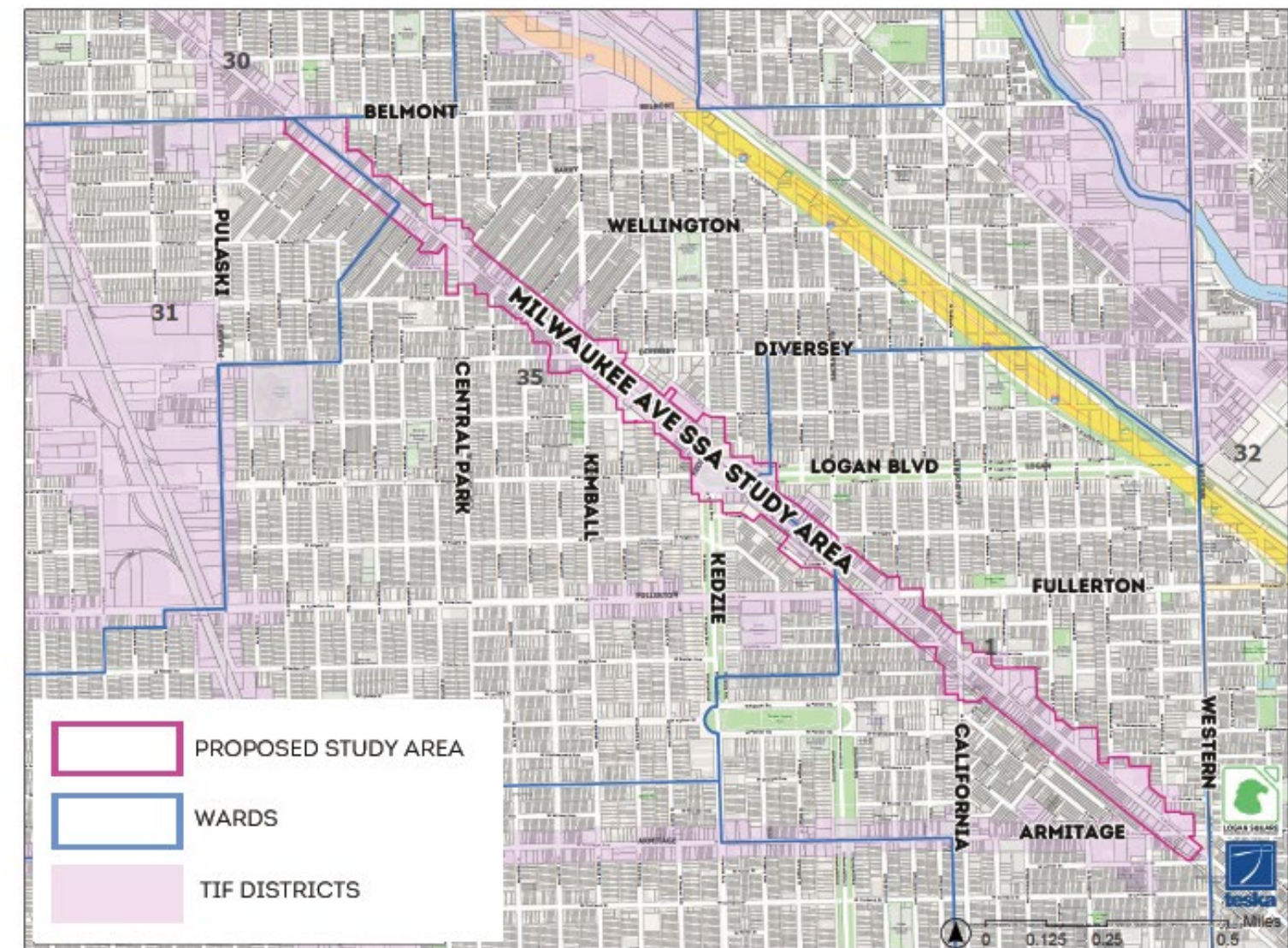

Signatures of Support

The City of Chicago requires signatures of support from taxpayers who represent 20% of all non-exempt PINs. The signature form requires:

- Maximum Tax Rate to Be Listed on Form
- Authorized Signature of Taxpayer

There are 651 parcels for signatures

- 10% of PINS: 65 signatures of PINs by June 14
- Additional 10% of PINs: 65 more signatures by August 1
